The Aerodigestive tract controls a person's breathing, swallowing, and digestion. It's a complex and coordinated system that directly impacts the body's growth and development. Disorders of the aerodigestive system can crossover systems and specialties, which makes Gillette's multidisciplinary approach to patient care perfect for getting your child a comprehensive treatment plan.

Gillette's Aerodigestive Clinic helps families navigate the complex medical needs of children with airway, respiratory, gastrointestinal and feeding concerns.

What is the Aerodigestive Clinic?

The clinic is an important tool for evaluation and treatment of children who have aerodigestive conditions like:

What to Expect at the Aerodigestive Clinic

At our Aerodigestive Clinic, Gillette patients from age 1 to 40 will see many medical experts in one visit, including a **pediatric physician**, a **pulmonologist**, a pediatric ear, **nose and throat (ENT) physician** and a **speech therapist**. These experts work together as a multidisciplinary team to evaluate, screen and diagnose children who are experiencing aerodigestive problems. They will also assist in creating a treatment plan.

Gillette's team of specialists will:

- Conduct a comprehensive same-day evaluation of your child's aerodigestive tract.
- Coordinate testing and evaluation both before and during appointments.
- Work with you and your child to establish a treatment plan.
